CLINTON HIGH SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN GOALS

- Increase the number of students and parent satisfied with the safety and security of school
- Increase the overall percentage of students meeting standard (test score of 60 or higher) on state mandated End of Course test from 72% to 82%.
- Increase the number of students meeting benchmarks on college readiness tests.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving platinum, gold or silver on ACT WorkKeys.
- Increase the on-time graduation rate from 72.9% to 88.4% by 2021.
- Increase the number of teachers trained in AVID
- Increase the number of teachers trained in project based learning and personalized learning.
- Increase the number of teachers scoring at the highest levels on the SCDE Teacher Evaluation system.

All students at Clinton High School are provided with a Chromebook for 1:1 technology across all subject areas.

- 75.7% of Clinton High School seniors are eligible for the Life/Palmetto Fellow
 Scholarship compared to the state average of 36%.



- **90.5%** of Clinton High School 11th/12th grade students enrolled in dual enrollment courses complete at least six hours with a C or better.
- **85.6% of 2017 graduates from Clinton High** are currently enrolled in a two or four year college or technical college.
- **26.9% of Clinton High students participate in work based experiences**, an increase from 14.4%.
- 51% of students taking AP courses score a 3 or higher on the AP exam.
- 68.6% of Clinton High teachers have advanced degrees.
