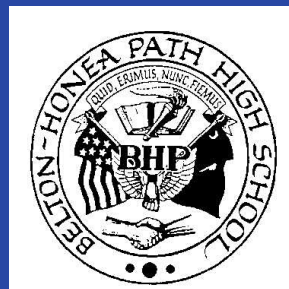

Biology I - 51.9% Passing

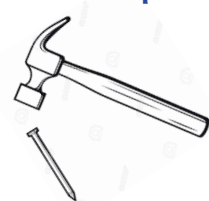

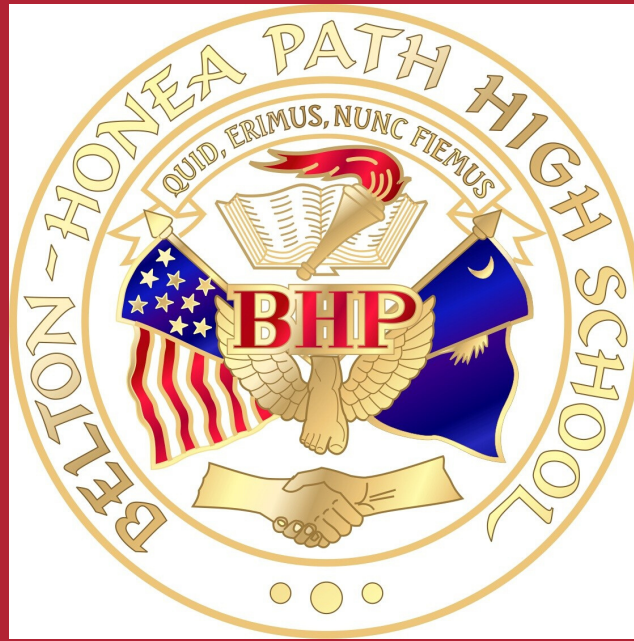
