Increase parent engagement to support the school's vision, environment, and activities.

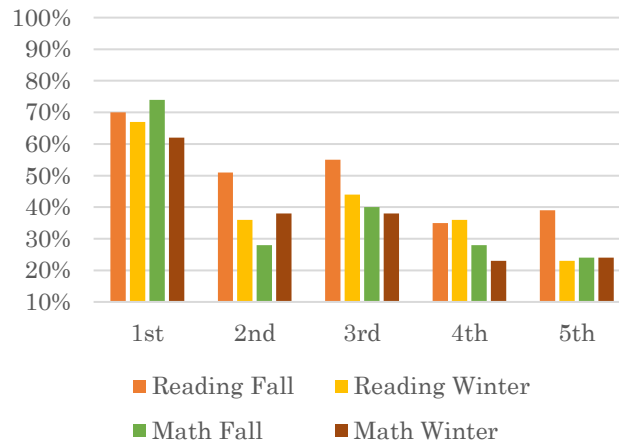
## ***Strategy #2: Parent Education***

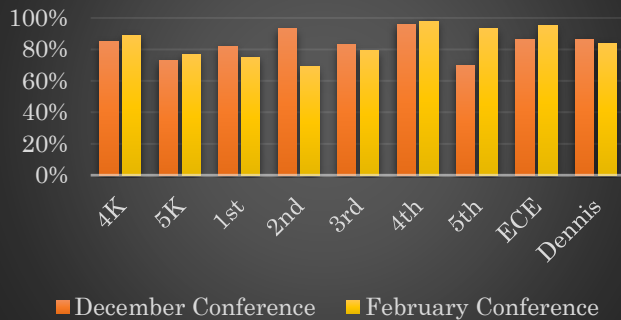
