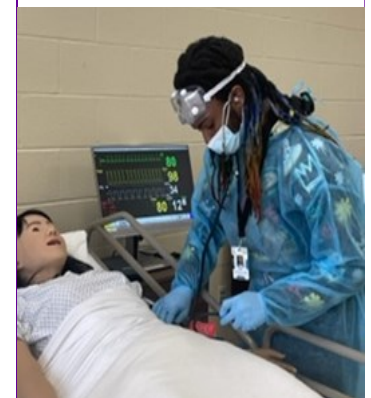
4S1: Non-Traditional Program Concentration

There are currently two females enrolled in the Principles of Engineering Program, one female in Mechatronics Integrated Technologies 1, Automotive, and the Welding Programs and one male enrolled in the Health Science Program. "Under Perkins V, states are required to report annually on the following core indicators of performance. States are also required to report disaggregated data on the performance of students by gender, race/ethnicity, special population categories, and career clusters. The percentage of CTE concentrators in career and technical education programs and programs of study that lead to non-traditional fields. This means that a student gets counted under this indicator if individuals from their gender comprise less than 25 percent of the individuals employed in the related occupation or field of work." According to the U.S. Department of Labor, a non-traditional career or a non-traditional occupation (NTO) is one where one gender (male or female) comprises less than 25% of those employed.

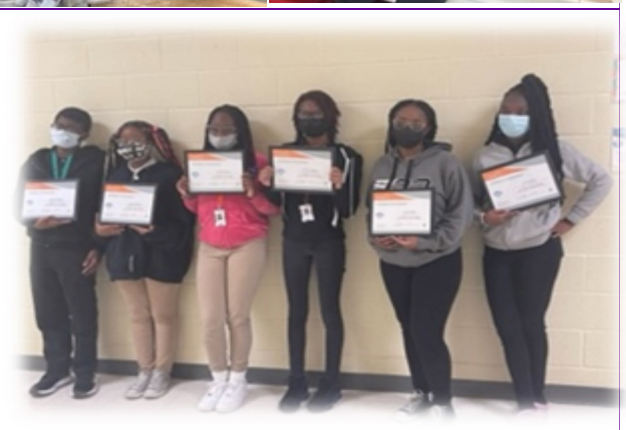

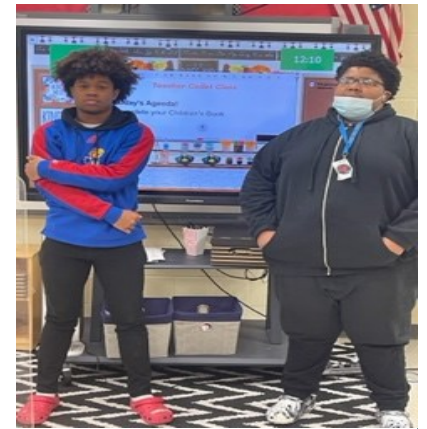

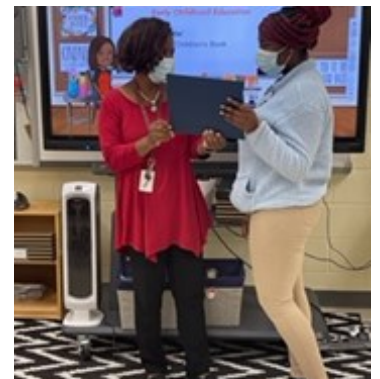


**Director’s Recognition Board

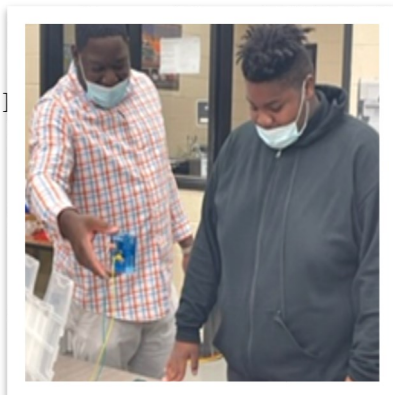
