Recent Graduates

Our staff and students were encouraged by the success of the PHS class of 2012. This class contained a National Merit Scholarship Commended student, a Palmetto Fellows Scholarship recipient, 75 students who qualified for State Merit Scholarships, 20 students with a 4.0 or higher GPA, and recipients of 3.1 million dollars in scholarships for college. The average composite SAT score was 1451, which is above the State average and the second highest in Lexington School District One.

Academic Progress

This year the Center for Advanced Agribusiness research expanded curricular opportunities to include dual-enrollment courses through Piedmont Technical College and additional Advanced Placement and honors course offerings.

Pelion High also extended student opportunities by adding upper-level STEM courses, upper-level French courses, and introducing German courses to our curriculum.

Students and teachers continue to embrace the use of iPads in the Mobile Computing Initiative through real-world applications that support a 21st century learning experience.

Goals

By 2015, 85% of students will graduate from Pelion High School in four years.

By 2012, 76% of students will graduate from Pelion High School in four years.

The class of 2012 graduation rate was 79.6%, the highest in school history.

By 2015, 70% of students will attain Level 3 or higher as measured by the state assessment (HSAP).

By 2012, 49% will attain a Level 3 of higher on the English portion of the state assessment and 56% of students will attain a Level 3 or higher on the math portion as measured by the state assessment (HSAP).

We exceeded our 2012 goal with 55.7% of students attaining a 3 or higher on the English portion and 56.6% attaining a 3 or higher on the math portion of the HSAP.

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By 2015 the percent of students passing the EOCEP in Algebra 1 and English 1 will increase by 1% annually while the passing rate in US History and Biology will increase by 2% annually from the 2009-2010 scores.

The Fall of 2012 resulted in the highest EOCEP passage rates in school history with the following:

Algebra 1- 86.2% US History- 59.0% English 1- 68.0% Biology-72.6%
