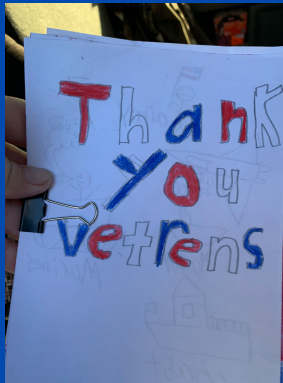


CELEBRATIONS

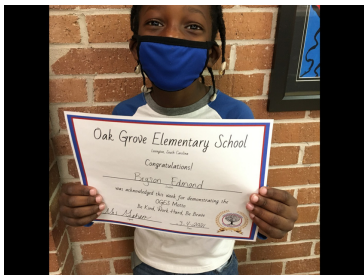
