WHITE KNOLL ELEMENTARY (WKE) OPENED ITS DOORS IN 1990. IT CONSISTS OF MORE THAN 100,000 SQ. FEET OF LEARNING SPACE. IT WAS BUILT AT A COST OF \$5,500,000 AND IS LOCATED ACROSS THE STREET FROM THE SITE OF THE ORIGINAL WHITE KNOLL SCHOOL, WHICH OPENED IN 1920.

How Are We Achieving Our Goals?

These goals are reviewed monthly by the SIC, School Leadership Team, and faculty to assess programs toward achievement and determine ongoing strategies for successful attainment.

Palmetto Assessment of State Standards (PASS) & ACT Aspire

Aligned to the state academic standards, these assessments include writing, English language arts (reading and research), mathematics, science and social studies. The percentage of WKE students who scored "Met/Ready" and "Exemplary" for the 14-15 school year are: Soc. Studies - 79%; Science - 73%; Math - 54%; ELA - 68%



Community Involvement

- Snack Pack Program - In conjunction with Emmanuel Baptist and Willow Ridge Churches students gathered non-perishable food items for take-home meals
- Toys for Tots - Student council coordinated a school-wide effort and collected 4 barrels of toys as well as raised \$400 to purchase toys.
