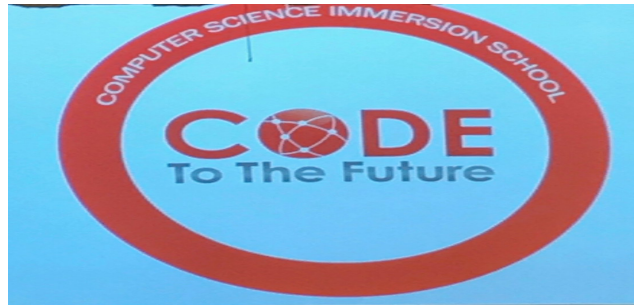

WHITE KNOLL ELEMENTARY (WKE) OPENED ITS DOORS IN 1990. IT CONSISTS OF MORE THAN 100,000 SQ. FEET OF LEARNING SPACE. IT WAS BUILT AT A COST OF \$5,500,000 AND IS LOCATED ACROSS THE STREET FROM THE SITE OF THE ORIGINAL WHITE KNOLL SCHOOL, WHICH OPENED IN 1920.

OVER 3000 STUDENTS HAVE BEEN SERVED BY WKE. CURRENTLY THERE ARE APPROXIMATELY 800 STUDENTS SERVED BY 95 FACULTY AND STAFF MEMBERS.

Palmetto Assessment of State Standards (PASS) SC Ready

Aligned to the state academic standards, these assessments include writing, English language arts (reading and research), mathematics, science and social studies. The percentage of WKE students who scored "Met/Ready" and "Exemplary" for the 15-16 school year are: Soc. Studies - 79%; Science - 73%; Math - 54%; ELA - 68%
