1 – The average percentage of our students in grade six through eight scoring met or above on State Assessments in the four content areas will be 83.45%.

2 – Provide alternative instructional methods and real-life applications of knowledge and skills to improve proficiencies of students with varied learning styles

3 – To provide purposeful, planned and progressive educational opportunities and intervention strategies that meet the social, emotional, intellectual, and physical needs of adolescent students.

The purpose of the SIC annual goals is to steadily progress the school forward in all areas consistent with the school's mission. We believe that by targeting the above areas that we will not only prepare our students for the high school, but that we will have helped to shape a generation of students for success in our community.

Student Achievement

Belton Middle School was rated Good/Average on the State's school report card in 2016 and received an ESEA grade of "B". The projection for this year is also a grade of B.

2016 Scores

71% of all students scored Met or above in the areas of Science and Social Studies on SC PASS. This was the first year assessed using the new SC Ready Assessment for ELA and Math and 44% were approaching the target while 33% were meeting or exceeding the target measure.

100% of Algebra I students passed the state's End-of-Course Exam while 94% passed the English I Exam.
