In an effort to better prepare our students for the rigor of State Assessments and future course work we have focused on our Assessments and the use of data to guide our instruction. With the addition of Instructional Coaches, we have worked hard to ensure our Assessments are rigorous along with our instruction. Our teachers are using formative assessment data to differentiate and guide instruction to meet the needs of all students.

97% of Algebra I students passed the state's End-of-Course Exam while 98% passed the English I Exam.
