The purpose of the SIC annual goals is to steadily progress the school forward in all areas consistent with the school's mission. We believe that by targeting the above areas that we will not only prepare our students for the high school, but that we will have helped to shape a generation of students for success in our community.

2015-2016 Goals (New School Renewal Plan)

1 - By 2020, the average percentage of students in grades 6-8 scoring met or above, or the equivalent, on state assessments in the four content areas will be 85 % or above.

2 - Annually, teachers and administrators will participate in high quality professional development that focuses on increasing teacher's expertise in using engaging instructional strategies, motivating learners, and creating quality assessments aligned to district goals as evidenced by professional development days on the state report card.

-Maintain 100% highly-qualified teacher and staff status.

3 - To provide purposeful, planned and progressive educational opportunities and intervention strategies that meet the social, emotional, intellectual, and physical needs of adolescent students. This will be measured using state report card data in regards to learning environment, social and physical environment, and school-home relations.

Student Achievement

Belton Middle School was rated Good/Average on the State's school report card in 2014 and received an ESEA grade of "B".

2014 Scores

76% of all students scored Met or above in the areas of PASS ELA, Math, Science and Social Studies.

ELA – 76% Met or Above
Writing – 77% Met or Above
Math – 73% Met or Above
Science – 77% Met or Above
Social Studies – 77% Met or Above

100% of Algebra I students and English I students passed the state's End-of-Course Exams.
