With a focus on student achievement and strong End of Course growth targets, we implemented our new 8 period hybrid bell schedule. Continuing on our success with daily HalfTime students who are struggling receive targeted intentional support. Our staff is dedicated to providing what is best for our students and the SIC works hard to support this mission.



Student Success

Academics

HalfTime allows our students the opportunity to have an hour long period each day to get what they need. Students are guaranteed 30 minutes of lunch. The other 30 minutes is used for required tutoring, intramurals, and socialization. A total of 2796 tutoring sessions were held this year, which equates to 1316 hours of individualized tutoring and tier 2 support. Teachers have a guaranteed 30 minutes of lunch, weekly collaboration time with their department, and built in time to provide tutoring and tier 2 support. Our AP enrollment continues to grow in the over 20 courses we offer. With a focus on tier 1 instruction, we hope to see much growth in our End of Course Exam scores.

Student Life

Brookland Cayce prides itself on its student programs. Student Government, ROTC, and much more continues to receive awards and support the school and community. Student Council worked to bring light to BC and its history. Our new dance program has provided students with yet another fine art to enjoy.
