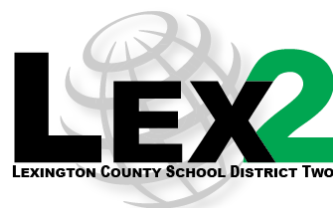

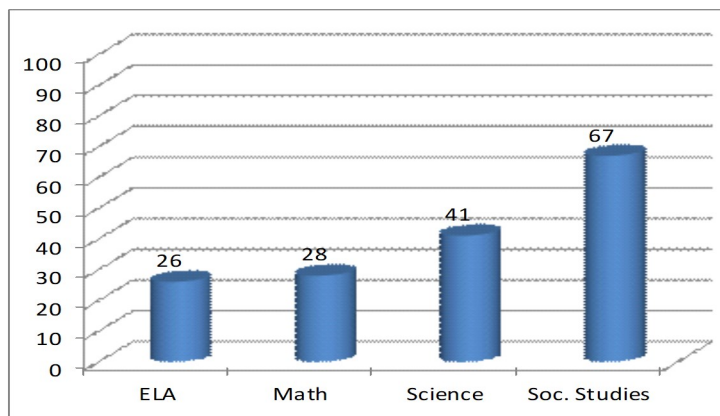


Test Scores
