Dear BLPS Families,

"Nurturing lifelong learners and leaders for the future" is the vision we strive to achieve each day at BL Primary School. It is important to us that we provide a safe and nurturing environment for every student.

Our staff worked diligently to offer two family literacy events this school year. During our Fall Literacy Night families were able to rotate through stations that included a read aloud, arts and crafts, parent education session, and trunk or treat. Our spring family literacy night centered around Read Across America week. Students read a variety of books and mapped out the birthplace of each author as they worked to read across America. Our spring literacy night concluded with our Character Book Parade.

We are proud to continue to offer two academic choices at BLPS that exemplify our personalized learning environment. Our Montessori classrooms are available to K4-2nd grade students and utilize a Montessori environment to promote learning and independence. Our K4 classrooms use the "Big Day" curriculum, which focuses on all areas of the SC Early Learning Standards. Our K5-2nd grade classrooms also exemplify a personalized learning pathway through the use of a reading and writing workshop model with an emphasis on building student foundational literacy skills. This school year, BLPS was one of only 2 South Carolina Schools chosen to be highlighted in The Canopy Project, a collaborative, online project that shares information about how districts and schools are providing

innovative learning environments to personalize learning and advance equity for students.

Our school mission this year is to ensure every student at BLPS is equipped with the foundational literacy skills to be proficient readers. At least 30 minutes daily is dedicated to explicit phonics instruction for all BLPS students. In addition, our 2nd grade students as well as our 1st/2nd Montessori Students participated in a daily Panther Power Period (P3) beginning 2nd semester to individualize phonics instruction utilizing a flexible grouping model. We are especially proud that students in all of our classrooms are learning to monitor their own progress and keep up with academic and behavioral goals they help create.

Each morning at BLPS our day begins with our student hosted news show. Our anchors lead the school with our BLPS Cub Pledge, celebrate birthdays and success, and update everyone on upcoming events.

Our "Happy Helpers" have been the foundation of our PBIS behavior model for the 2022-23 school year. This year students are earning Paw Bucks to attend quarterly PBIS celebrations that include a Fall Carnival, Winter Movie, Spring Dance Party, and an end of the year Splash Into Summer Party.

We would like to thank the BLPS PTO, School Improvement Council, and Lexington District Three Board of Trustees for supporting us and helping us nurture our students to be lifelong learners and leaders!
