This has been an amazing year at Batesburg-Leesville Primary School! I can't imagine spending my first year as a principal anywhere else. I have enjoyed getting to know the faculty and staff, as well as all of the wonderful students and families!

I am so proud of our school community as we continue to provide innovative instruction through the use of 1:1 devices. All students in 1st and 2nd grades now have a personal Chromebook, with which they research and create authentic projects. K4 and K5 students all have access to iPads filled with learning applications.

Communication between school and home has been enhanced through the use of technology platforms like SeeSaw, Facebook, and our new website. We strive to ensure that students have the skills to be successful in today's world.

Personalized learning has been front and center of staff professional learning this year. We have incorporated the use of student data notebooks where students can set goals and track progress in behavior and academics. Teachers have worked hard in accommodating student needs through flexible learning environments and providing targeted instruction. They have also attended conferences, workshops, and professional development sessions to enhance their

knowledge and skills.

This year we added to our leveled book library, as well as built a "Book Nook" where students are able to pick "just right" books for their reading workshop book baskets.
