

Community Outreach



- Toys for Tots - Students and Staff collected toys for needy children at Christmas.

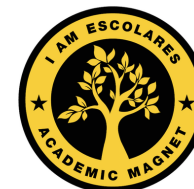

- Explore options for social and emotional support programs for after school.

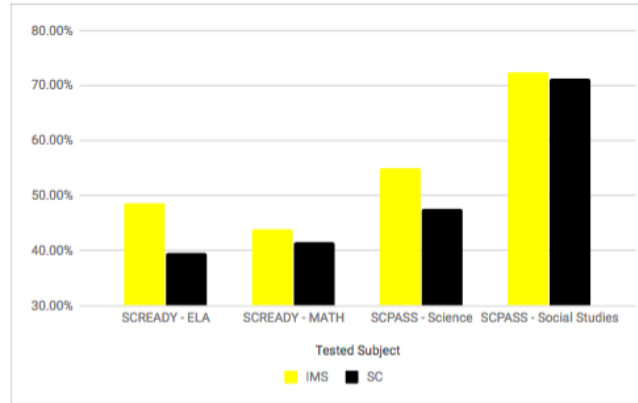
Awards & Honors

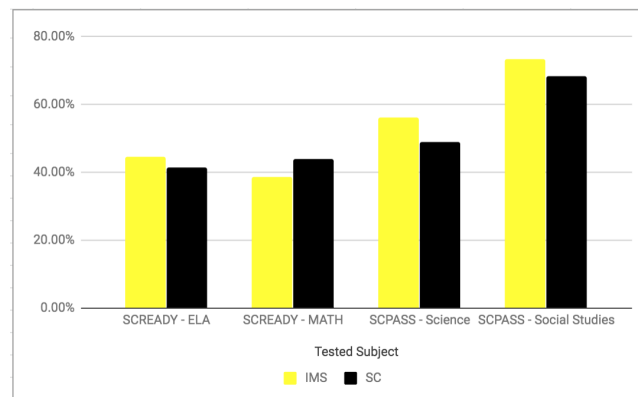
