Action Plan for 2018-2019

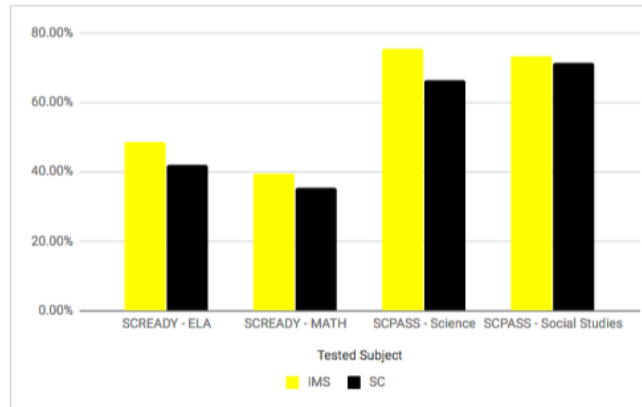
We plan to:

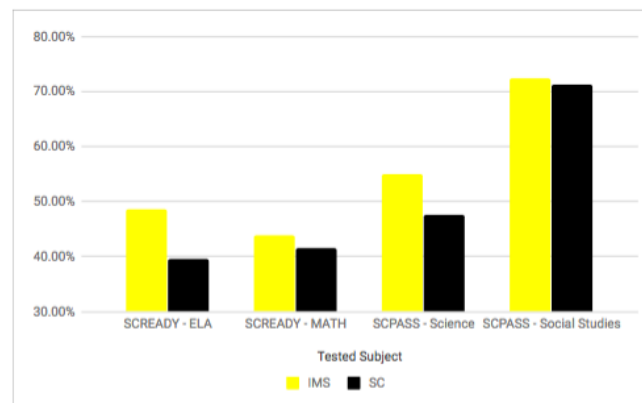
