- Increase the satisfaction of stakeholders through the culture and climate in all areas of school environment.

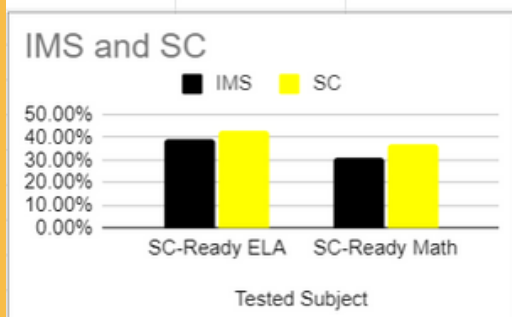
### SIC ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR 2022-2023

## COMMUNITY OUTREACH

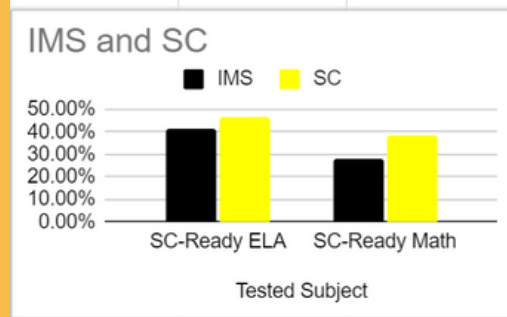
- Students at IMS donated 70 boxes of crayons and 409 books to be donated to local elementary schools and Prisma Children's Hospital.
