- The SIC will help to provide a plan for a successful transition back to face to face instruction.

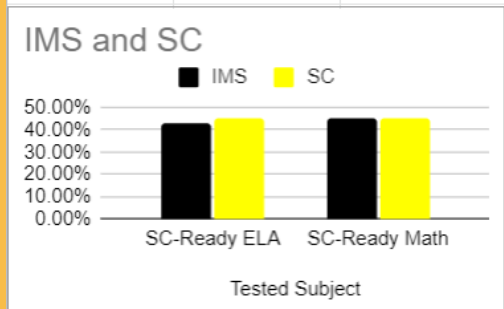
SIC ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR 2022-2023

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

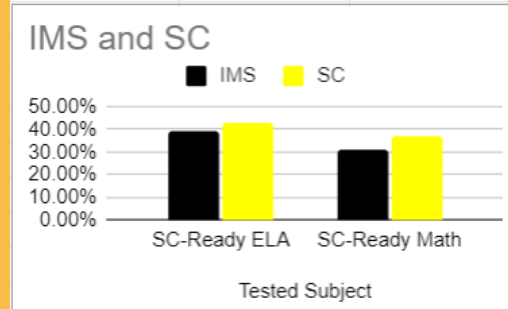
- Students at IMS participated in the Plusera Project and sold over \$1700 worth of bracelets that will go towards communities around the world.
