

# Community Outreach



- Our SIC initiated the creation of the Irmo Community IMPACT Coalition whose mission is to Improve Pathways and Chances Together within our community.

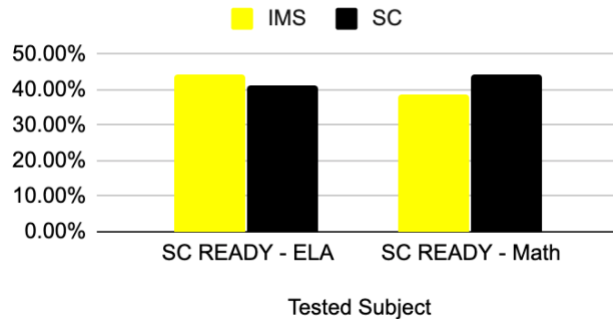
- Mrs. Paschal was nominated by one of the faculty members of the University of South Carolina as their College of Education Community Partner.

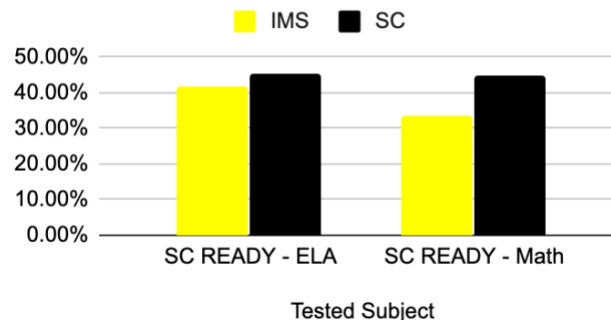
