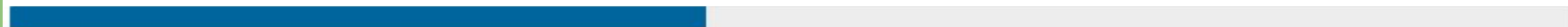

English Language Arts (Reading and Writing) - [Percent Met or Exceeding](#)

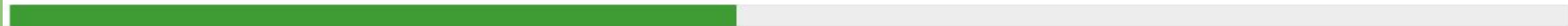

District 55.0% (4069 / 7403)

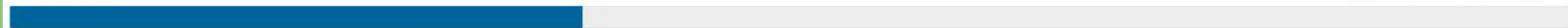


State 46.6% (160707 / 344866)

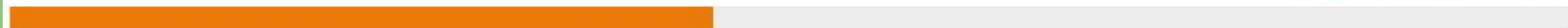


### Mathematics - [Percent Met or Exceeding](#)

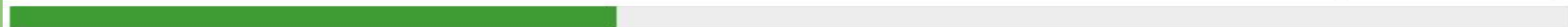
