# 2019-2020 Objectives of HE Corley Elementary School

- By May 2020, 58% of 2<sup>nd</sup>, 53% of 3<sup>rd</sup>, 34% of 4<sup>th</sup> and 61% of 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will score at or above the 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in ELA as measured by spring MAP scores.


