2017-2018 State Assessment Data

-Students in grades 4-7 scored above the state of students who met or exceeded on the state assessments in ELA, Math, Science, and Social Studies.

-ELA scores in grades 4, 5, and 7 were higher than the district percent of students who scored meet or exceeds on the state test

-Math scores in grades 5, 6, and 7 were higher than the district percent of students who scored meet or exceeds on the state test

-Our 5th, 6th, and 7th graders had the highest mean score in the district in math

-Our 4th, 5th, and 7th graders had the highest mean score in the district in ELA



Decisions based on State Testing Data

- Purchased more teacher resources to support balanced literacy instruction. This included more books to read aloud to students and adding more titles to our school library
- Share a new Literacy Coach as a new resource for teachers
- Provided an increase in training for teachers to enhance their balanced literacy instruction
- Purchased more Chromebooks so that each grade level has their own Chromebook cart
- Hired an Interventionist who targets students who are having difficulty in 1st-3rd grades
