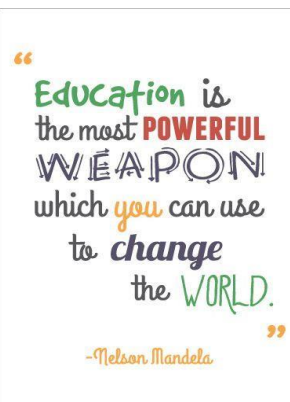

2020-2021 Action Plan

For the 2020-2021 school year, our grade level PLC (Professional Learning Communities) will continue to focus on fully implementing the E3 Framework, with an emphasis on Virtual Instruction. It will also focus on student strategies for reading and student data to improve overall student achievement. There is not Standardized testing data available from the 2019-2020 due to COVID school closures, so we will focus on Fountas & Pinnell and MAP data to determine the area of greatest need in grade level bands. Teachers will complete an individualized Student Learning Outcome Plan that will focus specifically on an area of need within their class based on testing data. Teachers will be required to keep documentation of student progress towards the goal set.

McColl Elementary Middle School will implement:

- Mastery Connect, Imagine Learning, and Accelerated Reader in an effort to motivate students to read, improve their reading comprehension, and advance their reading levels
- Gizmos to improve Science skills.
- Differentiated instruction daily to address the needs and learning styles of all students.
- Quarterly data meetings to analyze data, set goals, reflect, and foster an environment where data is valued and used to drive instruction.
- Weekly E3 Step Meetings to focus on student growth and strategies to improve instruction.
- Weekly Grade-Level PLC meetings to collaborate with teachers on planning and instruction.
