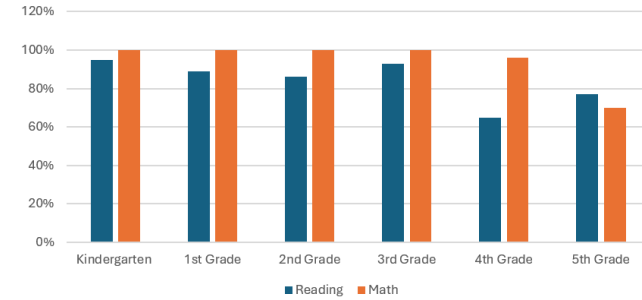


After School Program
