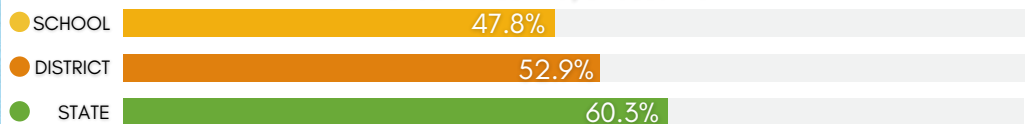

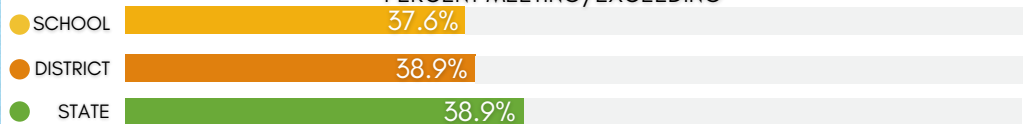

PERCENT MEETING/EXCEEDING



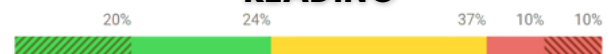
