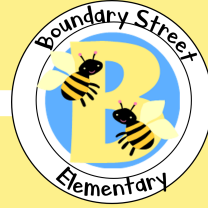
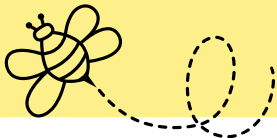


## *Mission Statement*

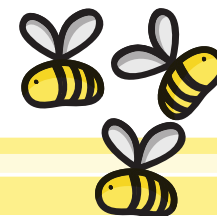
