The Gallman Elementary SIC works collaboratively to establish annual goals that support our students and overall school community. These goals target areas such as those listed below.

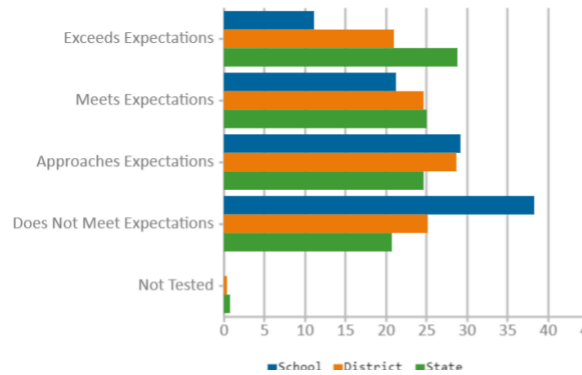
- Students attendance

The SIC works closely with teachers, administrators, and other school organizations like the PTO to discuss current school data, plan events, and address school and community needs.

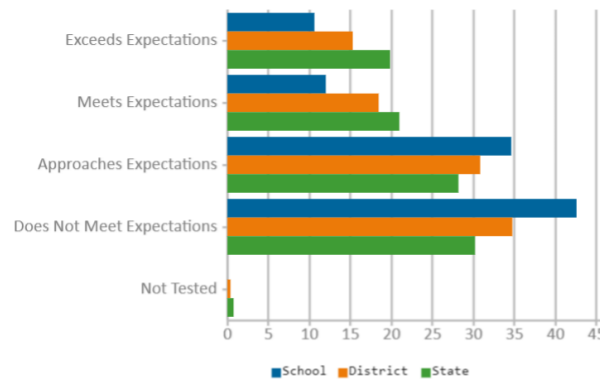
## Student Achievement
