SIC ANNUAL GOALS

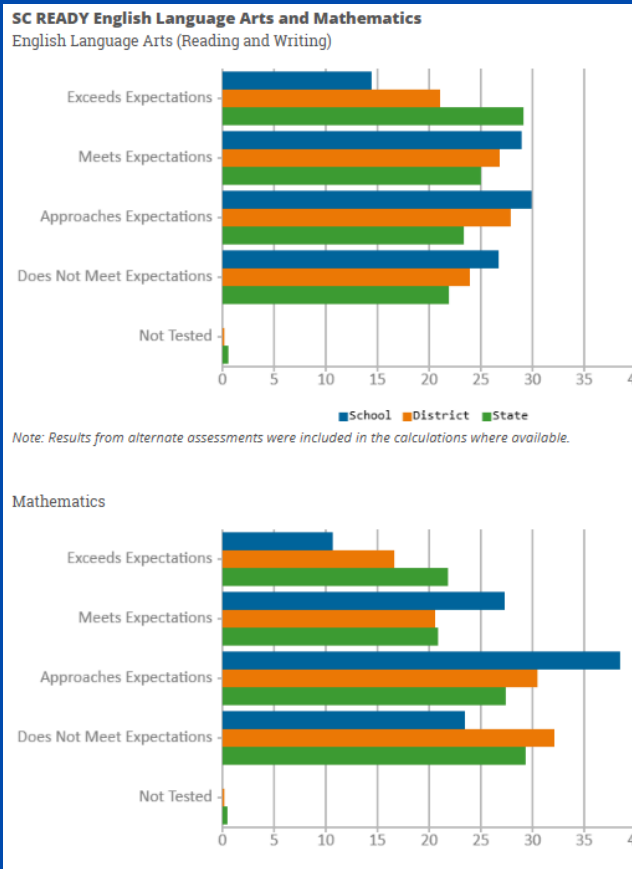
The Gallman Elementary SIC works collaboratively to establish annual goals that support our students and community. These goals are listed below.

- Keep parent and community members informed and involved.

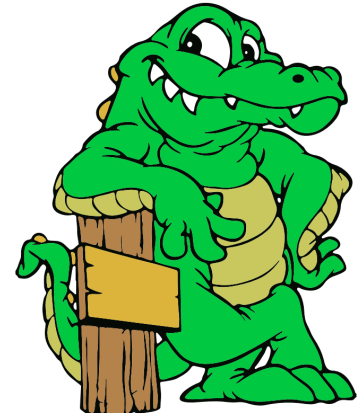


STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT
