SIC Goals

- **PERFORMANCE GOAL:** The percentage of students reported for chronic absenteeism will decrease from 32.4% on the state report card in 2023 to 16% in 2028.
- **PERFORMANCE GOAL:** The percentage of students in 1st, 3rd, and 7th grades scoring at or above the Meets Expectations level on iReady Math diagnostic will increase by 5 percentage points each academic year, resulting in growth: 1st Grade students will improve their performance from 19% to 34% in 2028. 3rd Grade students will improve their performance from 16% to 31% in 2028. 7th Grade students will improve their performance from 31% to 46% in 2028.
