Prosperity-Rikard Elementary School, a proud member of the School District of Newberry County, is in the rural town of Prosperity. Established in the winter of 1997, the school provides a high-quality education to students in Pre-K through fifth grade, fostering a supportive and engaging learning environment.

Prosperity-Rikard Elementary School is led by a dedicated administrative team consisting of a principal and an assistant principal. Our faculty includes 34 certified teachers, among whom one is a National Board-Certified Teacher, and another has been recognized as the District Teacher of the Year. Additionally, our staff comprises six instructional assistants, five cafeteria staff members, and four custodial staff members.

We are privileged to have a full-time school nurse, guidance counselor, media specialist, and educators in art, music, STEM, and physical education. A certified speech-language pathologist supports students' communication needs, and we provide Multilingual Learner (MLL) services through a certified teacher.

Our campus includes a Developmentally Delayed Pre-School Classroom and a Multi-Categorical LD/SC classroom. A certified Reading Recovery teacher is dedicated to supporting early literacy intervention. Notably, 13 of our students participated in the School District of Newberry's *Finding Nemo Jr.* production. Ten of our students participated in the School District of Newberry County Fitness Olympics. Two of our students placed in the state BETA Club convention.

Our front office is efficiently managed by two secretaries, ensuring smooth daily operations. The 398 students at Prosperity-Rikard Elementary come from diverse socio-economic backgrounds, contributing to a rich and inclusive school community.

Prosperity-Rikard Elementary School fosters a positive, supportive, and safe learning environment for students in Pre-K through fifth grade. Our dedicated educators deliver engaging and rigorous learning experiences, utilizing diverse instructional strategies to meet the unique needs of every student.
