The Purpose of Report to the Parents

As required by Act 135, the School Improvement Council at Seneca High School has prepared this Annual School Summary Report to provide an update of our progress toward the school's major goals as indicated in our school improvement action plan. This report also includes accomplishments and test data from last year, as well as school improvement activities planned for this school year. Seneca High School State Awards

Seneca High serves 962 students in 9th through 12th grade. Seneca High offers meaningful programs ranging from Graduation Services for our most at-risk population to offering 21 Advanced Placement courses and the District's premier AP Capstone Program to challenge our most ambitious students. The continuation of a "CAT" Advisement Period focused on college and career readiness and College Application Month as well as encouraging enrollment in the Hamilton Career & Technology Center help equip students with the skills needed to excel after graduation. These programs have all led to a rise in standardized test scores and have had a positive impact in the graduation rate over the past five years. Seneca High was named the highly coveted award of Palmetto's Finest in 2017. During the 2021-22 school year, Seneca also boasts the Region 1 3A Boys Basketball Champions, an accredited JROTC Honor Unit with Distinction, a Gold FFA Chapter, the SC Music Educators Association Outstanding Music Educator of the Year, and the National Federation of High School Sports Softball and Track National Coaches of the Year. Seneca also has won 14 State Choral Championships as well as 19 State Athletic Championships. The class of 2021 earned more than \$20.5 Million in Awarded Scholarships, earned 15 SC Academic Achievement Honors Awards, had 15 Palmetto Fellow Scholarship students, had 44 Honor Graduates and 76 High Honor Graduates. It is definitely a great time to be a Seneca Bobcat!

Seneca High School continues to maintain satisfactory accreditation status from both the State Department of Education and Southern Association of Colleges and Schools / AdvancED. Seneca High School has been a *High Schools That Work* School since 1988.
