Seneca High School State Awards

Seneca High serves 961 students in 9th through 12th grade. Seneca High offers meaningful programs ranging from Graduation and Transition Services through a 21st Century grant program for our most at-risk population to offering 23 Advanced Placement courses to challenge their most ambitious students. The development of a Hybrid Program, Advisement Period, and implementation of BOBCATS Central help equip students with the skills needed to excel after graduation. These programs have caused a rise in standardized test scores and an increase in the graduation rate over the past five years. Seneca High has received the Palmetto Gold Award the past two years and was named a 2016 Top 20 Public High School in South Carolina by US News and World Report, as well as being named the highly coveted award of Palmetto's Finest in 2017. During this 2018-19 school year, Seneca also boasts our 3A Girls Cross Country State Championship Title, a female State of SC FFA President, a Gold FFA Chapter, 2 National Merit Finalists, as well as a female basketball student breaking the all-time scoring record. Seneca also has won 13 State Choral Championships as well as 13 State Athletic Championships. The class of 2019 earned more than \$18 Million in Awarded Scholarships, earned 11 SC Academic Achievement Honors Awards and had 16 Palmetto Fellow Scholarship students. It is definitely a great time to be a Seneca Bobcat!
