SCHOOL DATA:

- ♦ 2013 S.C. Annual School Report Card Absolute Rating Excellent; ESEA Grade = A.
- ◆ Southern Association of Colleges and Schools accredited and a New American High School Showcase Site.
- ◆ SREB High Schools That Work member since 1988; Project Lead the Way Engineering Site since 2001.
- ♦ WHS offers 23 honors courses, 11 AP courses, 9 dual credit courses, and college credit for PLTW courses.
- ♦ Dual-credit courses through Tri-County Tech are available at the HCC Oconee campus and on-line.
- ♦ WHS follows the A/B block schedule and requires that all freshmen take High School 102.
- ♦ WHS has programs in IROTC, Agriculture, PLTW Pre-Engineering, Teacher Cadet, and Service Learning.

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS DATA:

End-of-Course Exams (EOC)

- Passing rates for WHS students enrolled in EOC Courses were as follows: English I-83%, Biology/Biology IB-77%, Algebra I/Algebra IB-71%, and U.S. History -59%, with an overall EOC passing rate of 72.2%.
- WHS exceeded the state pass rate English 1. The state overall passing rate is approximately 75%.

High School Assessment Program (HSAP)

• The overall passing rate for WHS sophomores was 88.4%, which exceeded the state passing rate of 82.0% in ELA and math for 1st time test takers.

SAT and ACT

- WHS seniors exceeded the 2013 national ACT composite scores with a score of 22.0 (national = 20.4).
- SAT scores exceeded state and US means in all three areas. The WHS SAT Critical Reading & Math score average was 1044 and the national Critical Reading & Math score average was 1010.

Advanced Placement (AP)

- WHS AP scores exceeded both the state passing rate (57%) and the national passing rate (57%). Seventy-nine WHS students took AP exams with a 82% pass rate (scoring 3 or higher).
- WHS added AP Human Geography this year, for a total of eleven Advanced Placement courses.

ADMINISTRATION, FACULTY, AND STAFF DATA:

- ◆ Administrators- 4, Counselors- 3, Career Specialist, Certified Staff 55, Classified Staff 11, SRO, Nurse.
- ♦ 73% of teachers have advanced degrees; 44% are GT endorsed, 10 teachers are National Board Certified.
- ♦ The average teacher attendance rate was 94.3%.
- ♦ Mike Jensen, Social Studies Teacher, was named SDOC Teacher of the Year.
- ◆ Professional development activities emphasized implementation of the SC Common Core standards and common course collaboration.

STUDENT DATA:

- ◆ Current Enrollment: 956 students: 84% White; 12% Hispanic, 2% Black; and 2% other ethnicities.
- Percentage of students on free/reduced lunch is 48%. AP course enrollment is 14%.
- ♦ The average student attendance rate was 94.1% and the on-time Graduation Rate was 86.8%.

SCHOOL-WIDE GOALS:

- Actively engage students in the learning process by implementing new instructional strategies.
- ♦ Increase teacher webpage instructional resources (i.e. assignments, notes, homework assignments).
- ♦ Collaborate for common course alignment and implementation of the State Common Core Standards.
- Share common core teaching strategies through monthly sessions held during planning.
- Increase student pass rate through assigned Academic 3M Program held after school every Monday.
- Prepare for AdvancEd Accreditation Review by completing the Self Assessment process.
