

Named Palmetto's Finest School in 2008.

Palmetto Silver Award for State Test Performance (2009-2010)

Met Adequate Yearly Progress in 2010, making them 1 of 16 middle schools in S.C. (270 schools total) to receive this distinction.

Made Excellent on both the Absolute score and improvement score S.C. State Report Card.

8th grade PASS scores placed students first in the state in Social Studies and in the top ten of the state in Science.



RMS TRADEMARKS

- ◆ RMS begins each day with a morning assembly to greet students in the gym.
- ◆ RMS Guidance Counselors are certified Licensed Professional Counselors.
- ◆ RMS male faculty and staff facilitate a mentoring program, MAN-UP, for eighth grade boys.
- ◆ RMS partners with United Way to provide "Draw the Line, Respect the Line" a program that promotes positive youth development and reduces teen pregnancy.
- ◆ A high percentage of parent surveys returned which allows RMS to find areas for improvement.
- ◆ RMS has a daily 45 minute Core 5 period for student enrichment and remediation.
- ◆ RMS has a daily 20 minute Self-Selected Reading period.
- ◆ RMS holds a 5 day suspension camp in lieu of students being suspended out of school.
- ◆ RMS holds a "Building Bridges" dance for rising 7th grade and current 7th grade students to ease the transition to Middle School. At the dance, parent have the opportunity to attend a drop-in with other parents and teachers,
- ◆ School wide phone messaging system to parents that gives timely announcements concerning school.
