La France is proud to be a technology-rich school, thanks to strong support from our school board and district technology team. Every student and staff member benefits from access to digital tools such as Chromebooks, tablets, digital cameras, and interactive learning panels. Through our "1 to World" initiative, all students have been issued a personal digital device. Students in grades 5K–6 are equipped with Chromebooks for use at school, while our 4K learners use tablets tailored to their needs. Each classroom is also equipped with a ClearTouch board and a document camera to enhance instruction and engagement.
