Title I

La France Elementary is a Title I School which means we receive funds from the federal government to assist in providing additional instructional resources, technology enhancement, instructional staff, and educational opportunities, based on our poverty index.

- iReady literacy screener

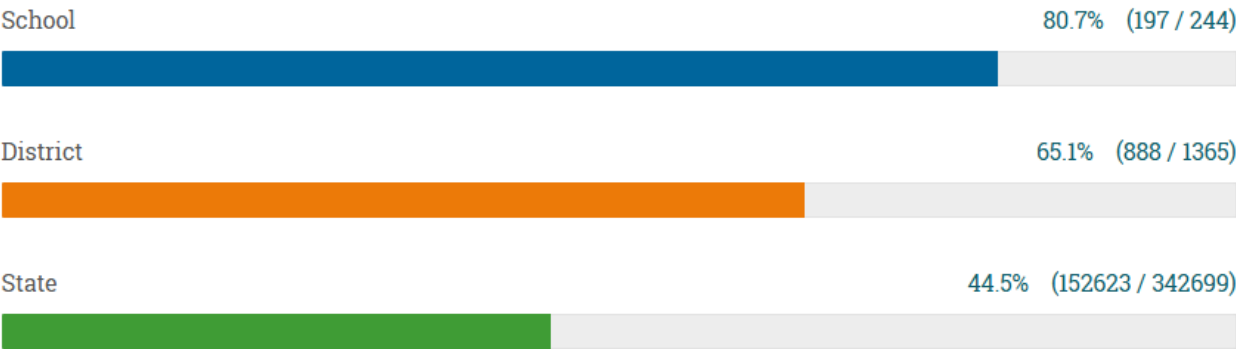

La France Elementary is proud to be a technology-rich school, made possible through the continued support of our school board and district technology team. Students and staff have access to a wide range of digital tools, including Chromebooks, tablets, digital cameras, and interactive learning panels. Through our “1 to World” initiative, every student has been issued an individual device, with students in grades 4K through 6 utilizing Chromebooks during the school day. Classrooms are also equipped with ClearTouch boards and document cameras to enhance instruction, engagement, and access to learning.
