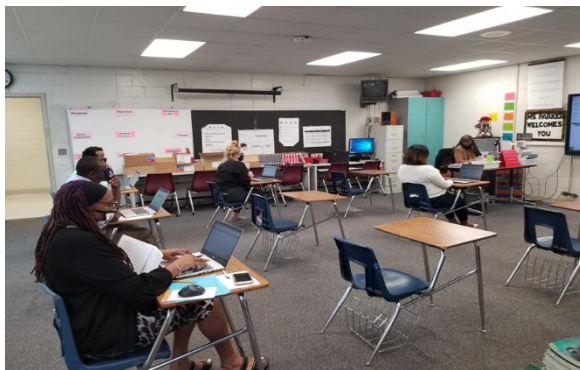


About Our School
