What is iReady?

i-Ready Personalized Instruction is for our 6-8th grade and provides an individualized plan for instruction based on each student's performance on the i-Ready Diagnostic test. Once students complete the Diagnostic, i-Ready builds a unique lesson plan with a starting point for each learner based on their individual results. i-Ready gives teachers the flexibility to add lessons or adjust the lesson sequence based on their own knowledge of their students.
