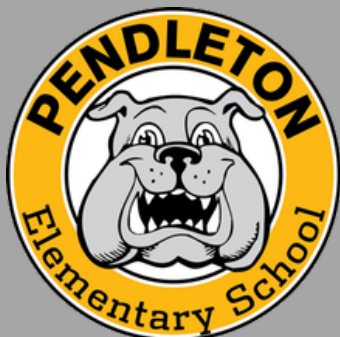

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN GOALS

- By June 2026, we will increase the number of 4th and 5th grade students scoring Meets and Exceeds in the area of math from 50.9 % (4th Grade) to 55% and 42.4% to 60% (5th Grade).
 - Based on iReady data, students in 4th grade are currently projected to be at 58% Meets and Exceeds. 5th grade is currently projected to be at 52% Meets and Exceeds.
- By June 2026, the three year average teacher retention rate will increase from 88.2 % to 90%.
 - We are currently expecting 95% of the teachers to return next year.
- By June 2026, we will increase the percent of teachers satisfied with how rules are enforced in the school from 80.5% to 82%.
