Global Studies at PES

During the 2013-14 school year, Pendleton Elementary School students across all grade levels participated in studies with a focus on Global Immersion. All students participated in family nights with global themes such as Holidays around the World and Tastes of the World. PES also offered a Spanish-Language Immersion Club, participated in numerous international Skype activities, and partnered with Clemson University to offer dynamic field-study experiences and a diverse range of inquiry projects. Each grade level focused on a specific continent to study in more depth. To build on

these successes, PES is adding a fulltime Global Literacy Facilitator in 2014-2015 school-year.

Pendleton Elementary also offers a full-time, embedded Montessori program for students ages 4-7. We're excited to be expanding this program to our 8-year-old students next year. This curriculum emphasizes critical thinking, problem solving, and offers accelerated achievement opportunities. PES also offers a gifted and talented program for our highest-achieving students. PES had students from grades 5/6 participate and compete in Model United Nations as part of the United

Nations Association of the United

States of America's Global Classrooms program.
PES continued its school-wide House system as a way to build character, unity, academics, and citizenship.
