PES STRATEGIC PLAN GOALS

By June 2029, we will increae the number of students scoring meets and exceeds in the area of math for 4th and 5th grade students from 33.9% to 62% (4th grade) and 41.3% to 68% (5th grade).

By June 2029, the three year average teacher retention rate will increase from 88.2 to 92%.

By June 2029, we will increase the percent of teachers satisfied with how rules are enforced in the school from 80.5% to 85.5%.

2023-2024 SC READY RESULTS

62.1% of students in 3rd-6th grade scored meets or exceeds on SC Ready ELA.

49.8% of students in 3rd-6th grade scored meets or exceeds on SC Ready Math.

Based on these results, we received an overall rating of Good and the Palmetto Silver Award.

INSTRUCTION

Our highly qualified teachers use state standards and aligned curriculum programs to support student learning. ASSESSMENT

Assessments are used to get the most up-to-date and accurate understanding of student progress. In K-6th grade, we use MAP diagnostic testing three times per year for math and reading progress. Other assessments are for specific grade levels or grade bands such as SC Ready for 3rd-6th grade, KRA for K5, and MYIGDIS for K4.
