## HIGHLIGHTS OF EPS

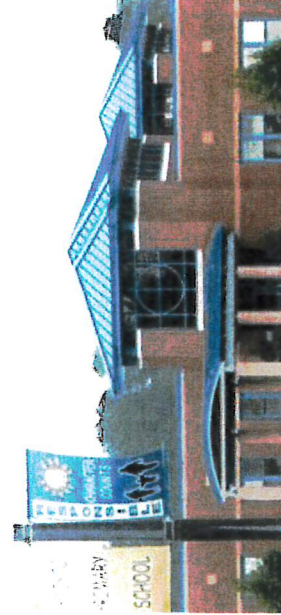
