Our school is helping all students develop the world class skills and life and career characteristics of the Profile of the South Carolina Graduate by providing all students with the instructional resources to help them achieve at their highest academic levels. Our faculty and staff focus on each child's particular learning needs, and our parents and community members provide assistance in many areas of our school.

Lockett Elementary students and teachers have become more involved in computer assisted instruction through programs like Mastery Connect, Compass, and IXL. Mastery Connect is used to assess students and progress monitor student achievement. Compass provides students with access from home or school in the areas of reading, math, science, and social studies. IXL provides students with activities to challenge their math thinking skills. The programs are aligned with the South Carolina State Standards and are designed to add rigor to instruction and help students become more career and college ready. Response to Intervention (RtI) efforts includes the use of Voyager, Reflex Math, Envision Math, and Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI) for identified students. All students in grades 4K – 5th have access to tablets to assist in learning and instruction. Every classroom has an interactive projector to assist in integrating technology into instructional teaching strategies.

Parents, students, and community members participated in our Fall and Spring Festivals, grade level student performances, Read with the Gamecocks, Father Daughter Dance, Grandparent's Day activities, Pink Out, Red Ribbon Week activities, Kindness/Bully Prevention program, Veteran's Day activities, Award's Day programs, Field Day, Careers on Wheels, Black History Emphasis, Read to Succeed activities, Food Drive for local food bank, and many other special events to involve the community in our school.

The challenge we face in meeting our student achievement goals is limited instructional personnel to assist with math intervention. Even though this is a challenge, the teachers step up to provide the best instruction possible to meet each student's individual needs.
