SIC Annual Goals

- The number of students in kindergarten through fifth grade older than usual for designated grade level will decrease from 6.40% in March 2022 to 3.20% by May 2027, as measured by grade retention data in PowerSchool.
- The percentage of parents indicating satisfaction with the school's effort to communicate important information as measured by state survey (April 2021) will increase from 83.60% in April 2021 to 90% in April 2027.
- The percentage of students in second grade meeting or exceeding state standards on the MAP reading assessment will increase from 30.6% in 2022 (winter) to 60.0% by spring 2027.
 - LES transitioned to iReady.
- The percentage of students in grades 3-5 meeting or exceeding state standardized ELA assessments will increase from 37.25% in spring 2021 to 60.0% by spring 2027.
- The percentage of students in grades 3-5 meeting or exceeding state standardized math assessment will increase from 27.45% in spring 2021 to 60.0% by spring 2027.
- The percentage of students in kindergarten demonstrating readiness on Kindergarten Readiness Assessment (KRA) will increase from 47.62% in 2021 to 60.0% by spring 2027.
- The percentage of students in 4th grade meeting or exceeding state standards on the SC PASS science assessment will increase from 50% (2021) to 65% by spring 2027.
- By 2027, the teacher attendance rate will increase by 1% annually from 92.9% in 2021 to 97% in 2027.
