SIC Annual Goals

- The percentage of parents indicating satisfaction with the school's effort to communicate important information as measured by district survey will increase from 78.5% in 2017 to 84.97% by 2021.

- The number of expelled and/or long-term suspensions will decrease by 50%. **Met**
