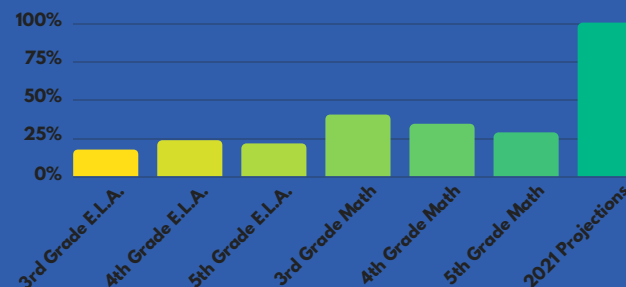
-All teacher at Edisto Elementary School Will implement at least one Inquiry Based Learning Project during the 2017-2018 school year.
