Title One

Townville is a Title I School which means we receive funds from the federal government to assist in providing additional instructional resources, technology enhancement, instructional staff, and educational opportunities, based on our poverty index. Additional reading resources are utilized in classrooms, in the LLI program, and our primary teachers have the opportunity to utilize various Orton-Gillingham strategies. All students receive need-focused enrichment during a 30-minute block of time each day. These blocks are staggered among grade levels and are designed to enhance academic acceleration, academic intervention, and fine art opportunities.



Title 1 Funds

At Townville Elementary, funds from Title 1 are used to fund:

- *Specific technology programs addressing math and reading achievement (MyOn Reader, Accelerated Reader, Happy Numbers, Education Galaxy, TrueFlix, BookFlix)
- *Math manipulatives
- *Reading/Writing support materials used for instruction
- *Instructional paraprofessionals contracts are extended 5 days to participate in professional development with teachers

*Library hours during summer for families to check out books & participate in literacy experiences

*Growth of non-fiction & fiction texts beyond typical classroom library
