Spring 2026

Facilities Update

During the 2025–2026 school year, Townville Elementary completed several facility and safety improvements designed to enhance school operations, student supervision, and campus safety.

Construction projects included the expansion of the cafeteria to better accommodate student capacity and improve the overall dining environment for students and staff.



In addition, the school's car rider loop was expanded through the relocation of Townville School Road, creating increased vehicle stacking capacity during dismissal procedures. This improvement significantly enhanced traffic flow and safety by reducing the number of vehicles waiting along Highway 24 and allowing additional traffic to remain on school property during dismissal.

Facility upgrades also included the addition of a restroom within the gymnasium area. This improvement allows students to access restroom facilities while remaining within a supervised instructional setting. Previously, students were required to travel outside the immediate learning area and near a main building exit to access restroom facilities.

To further strengthen campus safety measures, the district implemented the Centegix CrisisAlert safety system. Each staff member was issued an individual alert badge to support immediate communication and rapid response capabilities during emergency situations.

Townville Elementary's media center renovation is expected to be completed by mid-June 2026. The updated space includes new carpet, fresh paint, modern bookcases, and flexible furniture designed to support a variety of learning experiences. The redesigned library will provide students with inviting spaces for both independent learning and collaboration while fostering creativity, engagement, and 21st-century learning opportunities.

Townville Elementary remains committed to providing a safe, supportive, and engaging learning environment for all students. The facility improvements completed during the 2025–2026 school year reflect the district's continued investment in student safety, operational efficiency, and innovative learning spaces designed to support both academic achievement and the overall well-

being of students and staff. As these projects continue to enhance the school environment, Townville Elementary looks forward to building upon these improvements in the years ahead.

Title I Federal Program

Townville is a Title I School which means we receive funds from the federal government to assist in providing additional instructional resources, technology enhancement, instructional staff, and educational opportunities, based on our poverty index. Additional reading resources are utilized in classrooms, in the LLI program, and our primary teachers have the opportunity to utilize

various Orton-Gillingham strategies. All students receive need-focused enrichment during a 30-minute block of time each day. These blocks are staggered among grade levels and are designed to enhance academic acceleration, academic intervention, and fine art opportunities.

Title 1 Funds

At Townville Elementary, funds from Title 1 are used to fund:

- *Specific technology programs addressing math and reading achievement (Accelerated Reader, Happy Numbers, Magic School AI)
- *Math manipulatives
- *Full-time academic interventionist
- *Reading/Writing support materials used for instruction
- *Instructional paraprofessionals contracts are extended 5 days to participate in professional development with teachers
- *Library hours during summer for families to check out books & participate in literacy experiences
- *Growth of non-fiction & fiction texts beyond typical classroom library
- *Data Days with teachers to analyze data and make informed instructional decisions



Michelin Friends at US2

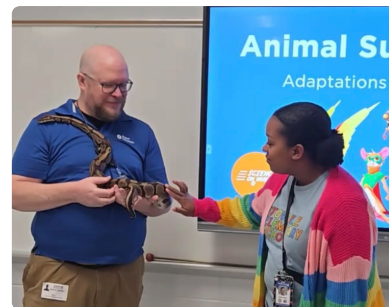

Student Learning Growth

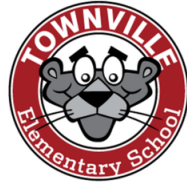

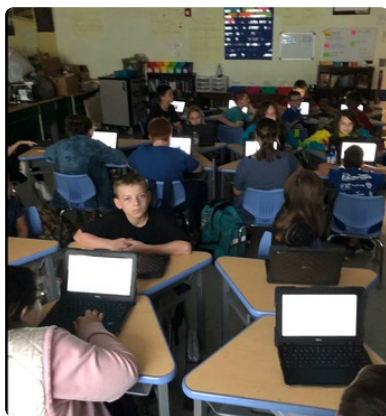
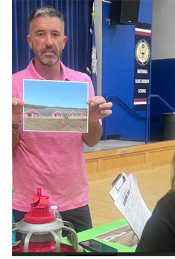
