This year, students were given the NWEA Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) assessment in the fall, winter and spring. Very few students took the SC Ready and SC Pass assessments during the 2020-21 school year.

2022 MAP School Data

English Language Arts (Reading)

- 18.2% of our students in grade 6 are projected to meet standard on SC Ready
- 16.3% of our students in grade 7 are projected to meet standard on SC Ready
- 19.3% of our students in grade 8 are projected to meet standard on SC Ready

SC Ready Mathematics

- 11% of our students in grade 6 are projected to meet standard on SC Ready
- 9% of our students in grade 7 are projected to meet standard on SC Ready
- 11% of our students in grade 8 are projected to meet standard on SC Ready
- 100% of our students in grade 8 are projected to pass the Algebra I EOCEP
